


Our History



The San Jose Shelter Foundation supports the various shelters in Santa Clara County which work to rehabilitate the homeless.




General Electric "Elfuns" at work at the San Jose Family Shelter.

Projects

Large projects such as remodeling, refurbishing, building, or landscaping require numerous resources. We find the necessary community resources to complete the work, refer community organizations who want to help, and manage each project from beginning to end. Some of our past projects include:

- Converting the Commercial Street Shelter into a shelter for women and children.
- Renovating and landscaping the Santa Clara Family Living Center.
- Rehabilitating an apartment building for a transitional housing program for the Emergency Housing Consortium.
- Refurbishing the dining room and public areas, painting the interior and exterior, and landscaping the Santa Clara Family Shelter.
- Converting an office building to a day shelter for homeless women and children, the Georgia Travis Center.
